Corrigendum

Note: The selected Implementing Agency will ensure that a **dedicated team** with a project lead is assigned for the purpose of design, development and implementation of the proposed ARTIS Web Application. It is strongly desirable that the Implementing Agency will not change the said team once deployed till the complete handover of the ARTIS Web Application. If any member of the team is changed due to some exceptional circumstances, it shall be ensured that the pace of development of the project is not hampered.

2. The selected Implementing Agency shall use the open-source platform/technology for development of ARTIS Web application which may be futuristic and flexible enough to accommodate the changes as and when required.

3. During the Pre-Bid meeting, the issue of web-hosting for the proposed ARTIS Web Application was raised. In this context, each prospective bidder is requested to submit two quotations, one with the web-hosting and the other without web-hosting in the format given below (Annexure V – amended Financial Bid format). The Department will take a call to opt one of these quotations after evaluation of the “with” and “without” web-hosting quotations.
