3. Issuance of final/provisional findings/disclosure against exports from India:

- a) On 3rd April 2023, the European Commission issued a disclosure statement in the Sunset Review of CVD on *Graphite Electrode from India*, whereby it recommended the continuation of the duty in force by a further period of 5 years.
- b) On 11th April 2023, the USDOC issued its preliminary determinations in the Administrative Review investigation of CVD imposed on *Certain New Pneumatic Off-the-Road Tyres from India (C-533-870)* for the period 01/01/2021 12/31/2021, wherein it preliminarily determined the following rates of CVD:

- c) On 12th April 2023, the USDOC issued a preliminary affirmative determination of circumvention of the Anti-Dumping Duty on *Certain Welded Carbon Steel Standard Pipes and Tubes From India* (A-533-502).
- d) On 12th April 2023, the USDOC issued a final determination in the administrative review of the Anti-Dumping Duty on *Certain Lined Paper Products from India* (*C-533-843*), whereby it determined the following rates of duties:

- e) On 20th April 2023, the Republic of Turkiye has issued its final determinations in the Sunset Review Investigation of Anti-Dumping Duties on *metal-bonded or metallized strip*, whereby it recommended the continuation of the Duty of 2.2 USD/kg for a further period of 5 years.
- f) On 31st March 2023, the USDOC issued its preliminary determinations in the Administrative Review investigation CVD imposed on *Certain New Pneumatic Off-the-Road Tyres from India (C-533-870)* for the period 01/01/2021 12/31/2021, wherein it preliminarily determined the following rates of CVD:

g) On 27th April 2023, the CSBA concluded the re-determination of Normal Value of the Anti-Dumping Duties in force on *corrosion-resistant steel sheet (COR1 2022 RI)* for

the period July 1, 2021 to August 31, 2022, wherein it determined the rate of duty as 40% for the Indian exporters.
