3. <u>Issuance of final/provisional findings/disclosure against exports from India</u>:

- a) On 2nd December 2022, the European Commission published a notification regarding the *global safeguard measure against certain steel products* and reported its alleged compliance of the WTO Panel Report in DS595. The European Commission recommended extension of existing safeguard measures against all countries including India.
- b) On 5th December 2022, the European Commission issued a revised disclosure document in Anti-Dumping investigation concerning imports of *Ceramic Tiles from India and Turkiye* whereby the anti-dumping duty rates earlier proposed on Indian exporters were reduced and revised as follows:

- c) On 6th December 2022, the USDOC issued final results in the Changed Circumstances Review of Anti-Dumping Duty on imports of the *Silicomanganese from India (A-533-823)* and found that the mandatory respondent, which was earlier called – Nava Bharat Ventures Limited – has changed its name, and is currently operating under the name of NAVA Limited.
- d) On 6th December 2022, the USDOC issued preliminary results in the Administrative Review of Anti-Dumping Duty on imports of *Welded Stainless Pressure Pipe from India* (A-533-867) for the period November 1, 2020 to October 31, 2021 and preliminarily determined the dumping margins at the following rates:

e) On 6th December 2022, the USDOC issued final results in the Administrative Review of Countervailing Duties imposed on *Glycine from India (C-533-884)* for the period January 1, 2020 to December 31, 2020, and determined the following net countervailable subsidy rates:

f) On 12th December 2022, the USDOC issued final results in the Administrative Review of Countervailing Duties imposed on *Finished Carbon Steel Flanges from India (C-533-872)* for the period January 1, 2020 to December 31, 2020, and determined the following net countervailable subsidy rates:

g) On 12th December 2022, the USDOC issued final results in Administrative Review of Countervailing Duty on *Polyethylene Terephthalate Film, Sheet, and Strip (PET Film) from India (C-533-825)* for the period 1st January 2020 to 31st December 2020, and determined the net countervailable subsidy rates as follows:

h) On 20th December 2022, Trade Remedy Authority (TRA) of the United Kingdom issued a disclosure of essential facts in the Transition Review investigation on CVD concerning *Stainless Steel Bars and Rods from India (TS0023)*, whereby the TRA proposed to revoke the duty imposed on Indian exporters. i) On 21st December 2022, the Directorate of Unfair Competition, Secretariat of Productive Development and Industry, Ministry of Economy of the Argentine Republic notified application of provisional antidumping duties against the exports of *New Rubber Tires (pneumatic rims) of the types used in bicycles from India* at the rate of 31.99%.

4. <u>Consultations/Verification/Hearing:</u>

- a) On 7th December 2022, the TDW participated in the oral hearing before the USDOC in the Countervailing Duty investigation on imports of *Sodium Nitrite from India (C-533-*907).
- b) On 9th December 2022, the officials of TDW held consultations with the European Commission concerning its alleged compliance of the WTO Panel Report in DS 595 pertaining to the *Safeguard Measures on Certain Steel Products*.
- c) On 28th December 2022, the officials of TDW held discussions with the United Kingdom regarding the transition review of the *safeguard measures on certain steel products*.

5. Other Actions and Follow-ups:

- a) On 30th November, the TDW held consultations with the Ministry of Economy of the United Arab Emirates pertaining to anti-dumping measures proposed by GCC-TSAIP on *Piston Engine Batteries with a Capacity of 32 up to 225 Amperes* from India. On 14th December 2022, the TDW provided written inputs to the Ministry of Economy, UAE.
- b) On 27th December 2022, TDW provided inputs to the Trade Policy Division (Rules), Department of Commerce on the Trade Policy Review of Malaysia.
- c) On 27th December 2022, the TDW prepared representations on behalf of the Government of India to be forwarded to the GCC-Member States in the anti-dumping measures proposed by the *GCC-TSAIP on Container Board Paper*.
- d) On 30th December 2022, the TDW prepared representations on behalf of the Government of India to be forwarded to the Ministry of Finance, Government of the Peoples' Republic of China pertaining to the anti-dumping measures proposed by MOFCOM on *Phthalocyanine Pigments from India*.
