3. <u>Issuance of final/provisional findings/disclosure against exports from India:</u>

a) On November 1, 2022, the USDOC issued final results of Countervailing Duty Administrative Review on imports of the *Stainless Steel Flanges* (C-533-878) from India for the period January 1, 2020 to December 31, 2020 and determined the countervailing duty at the following rates:

- b) On November 1, 2022, the USDOC amended the final results in the Anti-Dumping Duty administrative review on imports of *Welded Carbon Steel Standard Pipes and Tubes* (A-533-502) from India and declined to find that a PMS existed in India during the POR with respect to the price of hot-rolled coil, hence determined anti-dumping duty for Garg Tube Export LLP and Garg Tube Limited as *Nil*.
- c) On November 4, 2022, the USDOC issued the preliminary results in the Anti-dumping Duty Administrative Review on imports of *Stainless Steel Flanges* (A533-877) from India for the period from October 1, 2020 to September 30, 2021 and preliminarily determined the anti-dumping duty at the following rates:

d) On November 10, 2022, the USDOC issued the final results of Anti-dumping Duty Administrative Review on imports of the *Glycine* (A-533-883) from India for the period from June 1, 2020 to May 31, 2021 and determined the anti-dumping duty at the following rates:

4. Consultations/Verification/Hearing:

- a) On 8th November, 2022, TDW participated in the oral hearing before the International Trade Practices Unit, Ministry of Economy, Mexico, and made written submissions in the anti-dumping investigation on imports of *Ferromanganese* (16/21) from India.
- b) On 16th November, 2022, TDW participated in the oral hearing before the European Commission, and made written submissions in the anti-dumping investigation on the imports of *ceramic tiles* (AD684) from India.
- c) On 30th November, 2022, TDW along with FT(WANA) held consultations with the Ministry of Economy, United Arab Emirates to discuss issues pertaining to the anti-dumping duty imposed on imports of *Piston Engine Batteries with a Capacity of 32 up to 225 Amperes* from India.

5. Other Actions and Follow-ups:

On 30th November, the TDW forwarded its queries/concerns pertaining to the Fifteenth Trade Policy Review of the United States of America.

In October 2022, the officers from TDW, DGTR attended the WTO Rules Committee Meeting in Geneva. On the side-lines of the WTO Rules Committee Meeting, the officers of TDW and representatives from PMI held bilateral discussions with the representative of Canada, Vietnam, UK and USA and raised issues pertaining to the following anti-dumping, CVD and Safeguard investigations against India:

- a) Safeguard measures by UK on Certain Steel Products.
- b) Anti-dumping duty by Vietnam on certain long fiber products from Polyester.
- c) CVD investigations by USA on imports of *Barium Chloride* (*C-533-908*) and *Off-Road Tires* (*C-533-870*).
- d) Anti-dumping measure by Canada on Certain Steel Pipes.

In the month of November 2022, TDW followed up on the issues discussed in the side-lines of the Rules Committee Meeting in the following manner:

a) On 11th November 2022, TDW requested the Permanent Mission of India, Geneva to take up the issues pertaining to Anti-dumping duty on *certain long fiber products from Polyester* with the counterparts from the Government of Vietnam.

- b) On 22nd November 2022, TDW requested FT(ASEAN), Department of Commerce to take up the issues pertaining to Anti-dumping duty on *certain long fiber products from Polyester* with the counterparts from the Government of Vietnam.
- c) On 22nd November 2022, TDW requested the Permanent Mission of India, Geneva to take up the issues pertaining to CVD investigation on *Barium Chloride* (*C-533-908*) and *Off-Road Tires* (*C-533-870*) with the counterparts from the Government of USA.
