 a) On September 8, 2022, the USDOC issued preliminary results of Anti-Dumping Administrative Review on export of *Finished Carbon Steel Flanges* (A-533-871) from India for the period August 1, 2020, to July 31, 2021 and determined the dumping margins at the following rates:
