3. Issuance of final/provisional findings/disclosure against exports from India:

- a) On 5th June 2023, the USDOC issued Final Results in the Expedited Sunset Review of Anti-dumping duties on *Certain Cut-to-Length Carbon-Quality Steel Plate (A–533–817)*, wherein it has decided to extend the duty in force.
- b) On 5th June 2023, the USDOC issued Final Results in the Expedited Sunset Review of Anti-dumping duties on *Certain Lined Paper Products From India (C–533–844)*, wherein it has decided to extend the duty in force.
- c) On 06th June 2023, the USDOC issued Preliminary Results of Administrative Review of Antidumping Duty on *Silicomanganese From India* (*A-533-823*) for the years 2021–2022, wherein it preliminarily determined the dumping margins at the following rates:

d) On 8th June 2023, the USDOC issued Final Results in the Expedited Sunset Review of Anti-dumping duties on *Fine Denier Polyester Staple Fiber From India (C–533–876)*, wherein it has decided to extend the duty in force against the Indian exporters at the following rates:

e) On 9th June 2023, the USDOC issued Final Results of Expedited Fourth Sunset Reviews of Countervailing Duty Orders on *Certain Cut-to-Length Carbon-Quality Steel Plate*

(C-533-818), wherein it decided to extend the duty in force against the Indian exporters at the following rates:

f) On 9th June 2023, the USDOC issued Final Results of Antidumping Duty Administrative Review on *Welded Stainless Pressure Pipe (A–533–867)* wherein it decided to extend the duty in force against the Indian exporters at the following rates:

g) On 15th June 2023, the UK-Trade Remedies Authority announced its decision to revoke the CVD on *Stainless Steel Bars and Rods* pursuant to the transitional review (TS0023).

- a) On 8th June 2023, the Government of India participated in the oral hearings of the Safeguard Investigation on Wheat Products conducted by the Government of Madagascar.
- b) On 9th June 2023, the Government of India participated in the pre-initiation consultations in relation to CVD Petition received by the USDOC on Paper Shopping Bags (C-533-918).
- c) On 13th June 2023, the Government of India participated in consultations with the European Commission regarding the safeguard measures imposed by the EU on certain steel products.
