

Report of Trade Defence Wing for the month of November, 2020.

Submission of Questionnaire responses:

During the month TDW has made submissions in following Countervailing Duty Investigations initiated by other countries against exports from India:

- a. On November 13, TDW submitted the GOI response before European Commission (EC) in Anti-Dumping investigation on Stainless Steel Cold Rolled Products exported from India. EC on November 23, issued a supplementary questionnaire for GOI in this investigation and requested to submit the response by November 30, 2020. TDW submitted the GOI response on November 30.
- b. On November 19, TDW submitted the GOI response before Turkish investigating authority in CVD sunset review investigation on PET Films exported from India.
- c. On November 19, TDW submitted the GOI response on the supplementary questionnaire issued by Department of Commerce, USA (USDOC) in administrative review of CVD orders on Cold Drawn Mechanical Tubing exported from India.
- d. On November 25, TDW submitted GOI response before USDOC in first administrative review of CVD orders on Glycine exported from India.

Participation in hearings:

During the month, TDW participated in following Public Hearing before WTO Member countries:

- a. On November 20, TDW participated in Public Hearing before Indonesian Investigating Authority (KPPI) in Safeguard Investigation on Apparel and Clothing Accessories and also submitted GOI submissions.
- b. On November 30, TDW participated in Public Hearing before Taiwanese Investigating Authority through India-Taipei Association (India Office) and also submitted the hearing note subsequently.

Initiation of Trade Remedy investigations against India:

During the month, the following trade remedy investigations were initiated against India.

- a. On November 02, INDOCOPI, Peru initiated a Safeguard Investigation on Apparel and Textiles falling under Chapter 61, 62 and 63 of ITC(HS).
- b. On November 10, USDOC initiated the CVD investigation on Utility Scale Wind Tower exported from India.

Issuance of final/provisional findings against exports from India:

During the month, the following provisional/final findings were issued by other countries in investigations against India:

- a. On November 03, European Commission terminated the CVD investigation on Graphite Electrode exported from India.
- b. On November 05, National Tariff Commission, Pakistan issued the preliminary determination on Inorganic Yellow Chrome Pigment exported from India and imposed provisional anti-dumping duty at the rate of 51.91% ad-valorem of the C&F price on the import from India.
