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Report of Trade Defence Wing (TDW) for the month of January, 2022.

Submission of Questionnaire responses, Case briefs and Comments:

During the month of January, 2022, Trade Defence Wing (TDW) submitted questionnaire responses in the following Countervailing Duty (CVD) and Anti-Dumping Duty (ADD) investigations initiated by other WTO member countries against exports from India:

- a. On January 3, 2022 TDW filed comments before the Directorate General for Trade of the European Commission (European Commission) on proposed sampling methodology in antidumping investigation on exports of *Ceramic Tiles* (AD 684) from India for the period from July 1, 2020 to June 30, 2021.
- b. On January 4, 2022 TDW made written submissions before the European Commission and opposed application of Article 28 (Best Facts Available) in the anti-subsidy investigation concerning exports of *Stainless-Steel Cold Rolled Flat Products* (AS 678) from India for the period 1 July, 2019 to 30 June, 2020.
- c. On January 11, 2022 TDW submitted case brief to the United States Department of Commerce (USDOC) in CVD investigation for the period from January 1, 2020 to December 31, 2020 on *Organic Soybean Meal* (C-533-902) exported from India.
- d. On January 14, 2022 TDW submitted Questionnaire Response to the USDOC in the administrative review (2020) of CVD order on exports of *Polyethylene Terephthalate Film, Sheet, and Strip* (C-533-825) from India.
- e. On January 19, 2022 TDW made written submissions after the pre-initiation consultations held on digital platform by the USDOC in the proposed CVD investigation on exports of *Steel Nails* (C-533-905) from India for the calendar year 2020. The TDW requested the USDOC not to initiate the proposed investigation.
- f. On January 27, 2022 TDW filed questionnaire response to the USDOC in the administrative review (2020) of CVD order in export of *Carbon Steel Flanges* (C-533-872) from India.
- g. On January 28, 2022 TDW filed written submission before the USDOC, requesting it to not initiate the investigation subsequent to the pre-initiation consultations, which were held on digital platform in the proposed CVD investigation on exports of *Barium Chloride* (C-533-909) from India.

Initiation of Trade Remedy investigations against India and issue of questionnaires:

During the month of January, 2022, following CVD and ADD investigations were initiated by

other WTO member countries against exports from India:

a. On January 26, 2022 the USDOC initiated a CVD investigation on exports of *Steel Nails* (C-533-905) from India for the year 2020.

Issuance of final/provisional findings against exports from India:

a. On January 13, 2022 the USDOC issued the Final Results of Administrative Review of the CVD order on exports of Glycine from India (C-533-884) for the period September 4, 2018 to December 31, 2019. The USDOC imposed the following net countervailable subsidy rates:

On January 24, 2022 the European Commission issued the Final Disclosure Document consequent to the anti-subsidy investigation concerning exports of *Stainless-Steel Cold-Rolled Flat Products* (AS 678) originating from India. The European Commission imposed following countervailable subsidy rates:
