### Report of Trade Defence Wing (TDW) for the month of March, 2022

### **Submission of Questionnaire responses, briefs and comments:**

During the month of March, 2022 Trade Defence Wing (TDW) submitted various questionnaire responses, briefs and comments before different investigating authorities in the following Countervailing Duty (CVD) and Anti- Dumping Duty (ADD) investigations and reviews initiated by other WTO member countries against exports from India:

- a) On March 2, 2022 TDW filed written submissions pursuant to the Public Hearings in the Anti-Dumping Sunset Review (year 2020) investigation held through remote video conference by the International Trade Practices Unit (UPCI) of the Ministry of the Economy, Mexico, against *Carbon Steel Pipes* exported from India.
- b) On March 2, 2022 TDW filed substantive response before the US Department of Commerce (USDOC) in the Sunset Review of CVD order on *New Pneumatic Off-the-Road Tires* (C-533-870) exported from India.
- c) On March 8, 2022 the TDW filed written submissions after the pre-initiation consultations held on digital platform by the Directorate General of Trade, European Commission (EC) in the Expiry Review (year 2021) of the CVD imposed on *Certain Graphite Electrode Systems* (R763) exported from India.
- d) On March 25, 2022 the TDW filed response to the Supplemental Questionnaire before the USDOC in the Administrative Review (year 2020) of the CVD on *Glycine* (C-533-884) exported from India.
- e) On March 21, 2022 the TDW filed written submissions before the USDOC rebutting the New Subsidy Allegation (NSA) framed by the petitioner in the CVD investigation on *Sodium Nitrite* (C-533-907) exported from India.
- f) On March 28, 2022 the TDW filed New Subsidy Allegation (NSA) Questionnaire response before the USDOC in the Administrative Review (year 2020) of the CVD order on *Glycine* (C-533-884) exported from India.
- g) On March 31, 2022 the TDW filed initial questionnaire response before the USDOC in the CVD original investigation on *Barium Chloride* (C-533-909) exported from India.
- h) On March 31, 2022 the TDW filed initial questionnaire response before the USDOC in the CVD original investigation on *Sodium Nitrite* (C-533-907) exported from India.

# <u>Initiation of Trade Remedy Investigations and reviews against India and issue of</u> <u>Questionnaires:</u>

During the month of March, 2022 following Countervailing, Anti- Dumping and Safeguard investigations and reviews of duties imposed were initiated by other WTO member countries:

- a) On March 1, 2022 the Ministry of Commerce of the People's Republic of China issued notice for initiating Anti-dumping Investigation against Imports of Phthalocyanine originating in India.
- b) On March 3, 2022 Ministry of Economy, Mexico notified the Embassy of India (EoI) about proposed initiation of the antidumping investigation on imports of *High Carbon Ferromanganese* exported from India.
- c) On March 8, 2022 the USDOC issued a Supplemental Questionnaire to the Government of India (GOI) in the Administrative Review (year 2020) of the CVD order on *Glycine* (C-533-884) exported from India.
- d) On March 9, 2022 the EC sent a *Note Verbale* and Notice of Initiation of an expiry review (year 2021) of the ADD (R762) and CVD (R763) imposed on the *Certain Graphite Electrode Systems* exported from India.
- e) On March 14, 2022 the USDOC issued New Subsidy Allegation Questionnaire to the GOI in the Administrative Review (year 2020) of the CVD order on *Glycine* (C-533-884) exported from India.

### **Issuance of final/provisional findings against exports from India:**

a) On March 3, 2022 the USDOC issued Preliminary Results of the Administrative Review (year 2020) of the CVD order on Fine *Denier Polyester Staple Fiber* (C-533-876) exported from India, determining the following subsidy rates:

b) On March 10, 2022 the USDOC issued final results of Antidumping Duty Administrative Review (period August 1, 2019, through July 31, 2020) Investigation in *Finished Carbon Steel Flanges* (A-533-871) and imposed a zero percent duty on exports from India.

c) On March 16, 2022 the EU imposed definitive ADD (AD670) and CVD (AS 678) on *Stainless-Steel Cold-Rolled Flat Products* originating/exported from India, establishing the following countervailable subsidy amounts:
